***Welcome to the Golden Bar Cottage at
Tamarack... we hope you enjoy your stay!***

We are very happy that you have chosen to stay at our cottage in Tamarack Resort. This beautiful cottage is not part of the Tamarack Rental Properties and we open our home only to invited guests, friends and family. We hope that you treat our home as you would your own and we really want you to enjoy your time at this spectacular place. Please read through this informational sheet and you should find everything you need to know to make your stay as easy and pleasant as possible.



About the Cottage:

Our Tamarack Cottage is a beautiful two bedroom unit located at the end of a quiet cul-de-sac. The unit is two-story with two master bedroom suites. The upstairs master includes a queen bed, full bath and walk-in closet. The downstairs master has a king bed with private access to the outside deck and hot tub. The cottage also has sofa in the living room to accommodate a total of up to five guests.





Our cottage has a full complement of kitchen accessories including a full size gas stove and refrigerator. We also provide place settings and utensils for six and a full range of cooking equipment. We have a gas fireplace for the cool evenings and cable television along with high-speed wireless Internet.



Below you will find more detailed information about all of these amenities. If you have more questions, please call us or send us an email and we will try to answer any questions you may have.

Note: *Our cottage is professionally cleaned by Lakeview Property Services after each stay. Please make arrangements for cleaning by calling April at (208) 371-8369 and let her know your departure date. The fee for cleaning is \$90. Please leave a check or cash on the kitchen table when you leave.*

Cottage Access:

The cottage uses an electronic key pad for access. You will either get a key code directly from us or from Tamarack Security. Upon arrival at the resort you may stop by the security office located by the fire station on Whitewater drive to get a key code or call 208-325-1066 to make arrangements to get a code. Tamarack security is on site 24-7. If you have any problems contact me at (208) 859-7700.

To unlock the door:

1. Press the "Schlage" button at the top of the pad. The keypad will light up blue.
2. Enter the four-digit code. The keypad will turn green if the correct code is entered.
3. Turn the deadbolt clockwise to disengage the deadbolt.

To lock the door:

1. Close the door.
2. Press the "Schlage" button at the top of the pad. The keypad will light up green.
3. Turn the deadbolt counter-clockwise to engage the deadbolt.
4. The keypad will stop blinking after a few seconds and will no longer allow access to the deadbolt.



Directions to Tamarack Resort:

Tamarack resort is located approximately 100 miles north of Boise. A short and scenic two-hour drive brings you to this beautiful mountain retreat.

From Boise take Hwy 55 north to Donnelly, Idaho. Turn Left onto Roseberry Road; turn Left onto W. Mountain Road; continue approximately 3.5 miles to the entrance to Tamarack Resort on your right.

Directions to Golden Bar Cottage at Tamarack:

Take Village Drive (entry to Tamarack Resort) to first round-a-bout and turn right onto Whitewater Drive. Drive past the fire-station and turn left onto Golden Bar Court. Take Golden Bar Court until it dead ends at 125 Golden Bar Court.



Parking:

This Cottage has a single car garage. You will see 6 garage doors when you arrive; Our garage is the 3rd door from the left. It states unit 125 next to the door. You may park in front of it or along the parking area at the side. **Do not** park in front of other unit garage doors.



Other items:

Internet Connection- The cottage is equipped with high speed Internet. You may either plug into the router located on the bottom shelf of the small table where the phone sits with the Ethernet cable provided, or connect to the wireless Internet using the keycode is printed on the router.



TV Remote Control – The cottage has televisions with cable TV located in the main living area and in each bedroom. Each bedroom also has a DVD player. The entertainment system in the main living area is equipped with a surround sound system and Blu-ray player. For convenience there is a Logitech universal remote to control the television, stereo and Blu-ray player. The Logitech remote controls all of the devices with simple activity commands. If you wish to watch cable TV, press the “Watch TV” button on the remote control menu. The remote will then turn the TV and stereo on, and select the proper inputs. Similarly, “Watch DVD” will turn on the TV, stereo, and Blu-ray player and select proper inputs. All functions should be done using the remote control; manual operation of the devices can sometimes affect this universal remote control. Please be sure to return the remote to the charger on the phone table prior to your departure. Note that the Blu-ray player is connected to the Internet and has some additional content available such as Netflix and Pandora One.

Feel free to watch Netflix content.

Fireplace – The switch to turn on the gas fireplace is located above the mantle on the right side of the fireplace.



Lights – Several of the light switches for the living room and kitchen area are located at the entry wall to your left as you enter. Be aware these switches are located here. If you hang your coats on the coat rack at the entry, your coat will be covering these switches and you may not be able to find the light switch if you don't know this.

Grill – There is a gas grill located on the deck. You will need to open the gas line by turning the red valve located on the pipe leading to the grill, then turn on the burner located second from the right, and hit the ignition button. Please close the gas line after each use and make sure the gas line is closed prior to leaving.

Hot Tub – If the temperature is cold outside and you plan to use the hot tub you may want to turn it up several hours prior to use. Please turn it down to 85 degrees and re-cover after you finish using it and before you leave.



Cleaning Supplies – Cleaning supplies, dish soap, dishwasher detergent are located under the kitchen sink. Other supplies like vacuum cleaner, brooms, mops, pinesol, trash bags, etc. are located in the storage closet in the master bathroom. Laundry detergent and supplies are located in the laundry room located in the master bathroom. These supplies have been left to help facilitate the cleaning, however due to the fact that other, such as yourself, are using these supplies please let us know when you leave if supplies are low or please replace what you can. This is greatly appreciated.

Food – You need to supply your own food. There are some basic items found in the Cottage including some salt, pepper, sugar, etc. Please plan on bringing everything you need. Additionally, we have supplied a few coffee packages, creamers, sugar, etc. in case you forget to bring your coffee. Limited replacements can be found in the storage closet. Please replace anything that you use. Please take home all your food. While you may think that it is nice to leave some left over items for others to follow you, we have limited storage space and because

we do not know when the next person will be visiting, we do not want food to spoil or to attract any mountain critters. Thank you.

Trash Disposal – *Prior to leaving, please empty all trash containers (bathrooms and kitchen).*



Because we are not on a regularly scheduled trash pickup at this time, and because we do not want to leave trash out to attract wildlife, please dispose of your trash and recycled material at the trash/recycle center located near the entrance to the Tamarack property. This is greatly appreciated. The trash and recycle center is located near the entrance to Tamarack under the large open structure. The trash bin is the large green machine located to the right upon entering the structure and the recycle bins are all marked.

Ski Storage – *There is room on the back Patio to store skis, snowboards, and ski equipment. Please do not bring your snow covered equipment inside after use on the ski hill (until the snow has been removed or melted off) Ski-in ski-out access is directly off the rear deck on the adjacent ski run under the chair lift.*

Thermostats – *There are 2 thermostats in the cottage; one located in the living room (outside the master bedroom door) and one located upstairs. Please feel free to set the thermostats to whatever temperature is comfortable to you. However, prior to your departure, please set the downstairs thermostat to 56 degrees. This is sufficient to keep the property warm enough to keep any pipes, etc. from freezing and will reduce heating costs when not in use. Note that the upstairs thermostat does not control heat in the house. It was installed for potential control of a second heating system that is not included in this home. Also, the home does not have air conditioning. Normally, the mountain temperatures are cool enough even in the summer to preclude the need for air conditioning.*
